Indeed, in learning to draw upon its perceptions and elevated spiritual qualities, it gives us a doorway to the so-called higher levels of consciousness, in which it can access even greater Cosmic Wisdom, and even evolve itself.

Our real Journey of Life

This is why our inner self is the kernel of our greatest potential, and leads us on our true and authentic journey of life. In fact, just like an unfolding rose, blooms and infuses all around it with its physical beauty, so does our personal soul unfold to reveal our own personal inner potential and the spiritual beauty of our being. This ongoing unfolding occurs throughout our whole life and gives us a deep sense of personal satisfaction, purpose and spiritual adventure.

A deep and natural yearning to discover, to grow, and live life through the unfolding perceptions of our spiritual nature is what makes us truly human.

Awakening to the our Being

In striving to be, using our whole being, physically, mentally, emotionally, psychically and spiritually, we gain enhanced mental, emotional and psychic perceptions, including increased vitality, flashes of inspiration or intuition, and many other subtle perceptions which help to solve many complex problems and challenges of life.

Increasing moments of sheer joy, serenity, and tranquility, touched by an inner warmth of deep contentment lies ahead of us on our journey of life, once we begin to include our inner self as the primary agent of decision making, conduct and expression of who we really are.

The path of the Mystic

A heightened spiritual awareness can be called 'mystical experience', especially if it occurs directly between one's own inner self and higher levels of consciousness. Learning to skilfully utilise all aspects of our being, including, for example, transforming any hindering and unhelpful aspects of our ordinary personality, using spiritual alchemy is a part of what Rosicrucians name 'Mastery of Life'. Another way of viewing this self-directed transformation is the 'Mystery of Life'. A central aim of a mystic is to be increasingly in a more permanent state of attunement with increasingly refined levels of existence and ultimately, tapping into the creative intelligence of the Source of all Being.

Mysticism can be defined as an experience where one personally knows, through direct knowledge, the Source of all Being. There are many names for this ineffable source, because it is not easy to define, but Rosicrucians lovingly name their highest conception of the Divine 'The God of my Heart, the God of my understanding', to simply recognise that any naming is deeply personal and only their heart can name it.

This wonderful Universe

Our universe is made of laws of light, life and love, that contain a unity, an order, an exquisite collaboration of principles and intelligence.

Our Earth is a like a jewel in the cosmos, and is a masterpiece of divine universal consciousness. It is a special sanctuary upon which all life can evolve, physically, emotionally and spiritually. Mystical consciousness of the natural world and spiritual ecology is an important part of the Mysteries of Life.

The Ancient Mystical Ordo Rosae Crucis

The Rosicrucian Order also known as the Ancient and Mystical Order Rosae Crucis (AMORC) is an inclusive, worldwide, philosophical community; exploring spiritual wisdom and contributing to the evolution of consciousness. The work of the Rosicrucian Order is to initiate you to the techniques where mystical knowledge can be readily learned, in a rational step by step way, not as a belief, but as an art of knowing.

Since we recognise that the sacred dwells in each individual and the mystical dimension of all life, we welcome new members regardless of gender, race, religion or social advantage. Our members are asked to question the laws of the universe for themselves. We do not need gurus, dogma or absolutism, but instead encourage an inner desire to discover the Mysteries of Life.

Collectively as a mystical fraternity we seek to perpetuate Rosicrucian tradition as was historically revealed by the College of the Rose-Croix in 1614. The teachings trace to the Mystery Schools of the ancient world and pertain to the mysteries of the universe, nature and humanity.

Our work includes promoting greater peace, harmony and understanding for all living beings. The fact that you are reading this book is a sign that you are a seeker of the Mysteries of Life.

People discover us when they are ready

We are not a religion – we want you to question things free of fixed beliefs. We recognise great spiritual leaders from all times and religions, and consider them from a philosophical and humanist perspective.

The Rosicrucian system of study provides a foundation that ties together all different aspects of metaphysical study and demonstrates their interconnectedness. You will be shown how natural laws govern all realms of existence and, to experience various laws, our teachings offers a wide variety of techniques, including meditation, spiritual attunement, or developing psychic abilities.

Whether you see your journey as one of personal development, or the flowering of knowledge, or harnessing psychic ability—or of reaching the highest realms of spirituality and cosmic consciousness, the Rosicrucian Order's teachings are a comprehensive approach which makes your learning of complex areas easy. Step by step you'll see how each subject relates to the rest.

We hope to give seekers access to mysteries that have concerned humans for millennia. You'll learn about people, places and events that seem lost in the mists of time, but which are fully relevant today and indeed have influenced the evolution of consciousness. As you uncover them, your own wisdom and reflections of upon the meaning of life, will deepen, opening up a profound horizon, a new way of looking at the Earth and the universe.

The lost world

From around age nine we begin hiding our inner self away and start to forget the awe, the creativity and openness to the subtle impressions we had as a young, inquisitive child. Our school education probably taught us primarily a technical, intellectual and social framework to sustain a material life. There may have been a religious framework or cultural conditioning that even affected our innate, deeply ethical and naturally wise form of conscience. Or it may have affected the curiosity we held for the natural world as a little child. Furthermore, social media and artificial forms of intelligence are increasingly imposing their impressions upon the natural intelligence we possess as human beings.

Rarely, have we been supported in our development wholistically—with an emphasis on intuition, inspiration, the subconscious mind, focussed independent thinking, self-esteem, self-confidence, meditation, psychic or inner spiritual growth. Is it any wonder the inner self becomes lost in the complexities and demands of the outer world? Yet despite all this the inner self does remain alive in everyone, and is waiting to be rediscovered. This rediscovery makes us feel whole again.

A carefully curated pathway

The carefully curated learning pathway of the Rosicrucian Order has carefully preserved its experiential teaching methods that have a lineage right back to the ancient mystery schools. They are transmitted today in a contemporary language to any sincere person with an open mind and a positive motive.

If you're completely new to this area of study, you'll find that this comprehensive approach makes your learning easy. As you progress step-by-step you'll see how each subject relates to the rest, giving you a sense of completeness and confidence to move forward to the next stage.



Already a seeker...

Perhaps you have already traversed the vast sea of metaphysical and self help books and blogs, utubes and visited social media sites that offer a plethora of interesting advice, but still feel the need to bring a coherence and orderliness to your all different aspects of metaphysical study? Perhaps you wish to find and interconnectedness an ancient lineage of Initiatic Tradition? It can become a weary journey after a while if you are trying to find an order in the vast array of spiritual material on offer. Many of our students have already studied different metaphysical, esoteric, religious and spiritual traditions, even other Rosicrucian traditions, and yet still have found our teaching system deeply rewarding and useful.

...An open Mind

Whatever the level of prior research on the spiritual quest, it's best that you begin your studies with an entirely open mind. That does not mean abandoning prior knowledge, or severing ties with other organisations, but it does mean that you might wish to calmly reflect and question for a while, and, if some aspects are unacceptable to you, we do not expect you to agree with them.

The History of Rosicrucianism

According to Rosicrucian tradition, the quest for esoteric wisdom, dates back to the Mystery Schools of Ancient Egypt. In these ancient schools both male and female students and initiates met regularly to hold activities which enabled them to question the mysteries of existence. The word 'mysteries' in antiquity—that is, at the time of the ancient Egyptian, Greek, and Roman civilizations indicated a 'gnosis', an understanding known only to the initiated and transmitted under the seal of secrecy.

Ancient Mystery Schools

In ancient Egypt, one of the first Mystery Schools was the Osirian School. At that time, the teachings were presented in the form of ritual dramas. Only those who had given proof of their sincere desire for knowledge were allowed to participate in these activities. In the course of the centuries, the Mystery Schools added even more dimensions to the knowledge that they transmitted. According to Rosicrucian Tradition, the most sacred of these in the eyes of the Initiates were the three great pyramids of Giza which are a synthesis of the wisdom that the Egyptians possessed in arithmetic, geometry, physics, geography, and astronomy as well as the initiatory path.

Queen Hatshepsut, of the 18th Dynasty, (c. 1507–1458 BC), was one of ancient Egypt's greatest Pharaohs. She focused on collaborative and peaceful trade rather than military conquests. Her reign was marked by peace and prosperity. Rosicrucian teachings show that Hatshepsut's stepson, Pharaoh Thutmose III, (who is considered by historians to be one of the greatest rulers of the 18th Dynasty), belonged to the initiates who frequented the Mystery Schools of Egypt. During a period of co-regency between these Pharaohs, a single fraternity arose out of independent schools. In the mystically orientated writings and spiritual reformations carried out by Thutmose's 111 great, great grandson, Pharaoh Amenhotep IV (Akhenaten), we can experience a mystery school lineage being handed on. Akhenaten was married to Nefertiti, a person of high mystical qualities and with their family, which

included six daughters, promoted a deeply humanistic pathway of high ideals through new forms of art and culture. Although Akhenaten and his spiritual ideas caused disfavour with certain priesthoods, the tradition which we can evocatively feel call an 'Order of initiates' quietly lived on.

During the following centuries, numerous Greek philosophers journeyed to Egypt to be admitted into this tradition. Such sages as Thales and Pythagoras gained access to the Science of the Mysteries. Upon returning to their own countries, they established schools and taught what they had learned.

Their philosophy attracted numerous sincere adepts and exerted a great influence on the Eleusinian Mysteries. From Greece, the secret

Out of Ancient Egypt

Gnosis was introduced to Rome by the Gnostics and served as the basis for Neo-Platonism, whose teachings, established by Plotinus around the year 250, spread to the West under the impetus of Iamblichus and Porphyry. It was in the time of Charlemagne, thanks to the theologians Alcuin and Arnaud, that the Order was established in France, and then in England, Germany, and in other kingdoms of Europe during the Middle Ages. During the Crusades, many Templars participated in its work and contributed to its spread, particularly in the East.

The Medieval Alchemists

Between the 13th and 16th centuries, the traditional heritage of the Order was entrusted to the Alchemists, among whom were Roger Bacon, Nicholas Flamel, and Cornelius Agrippa, well known to Rosicrucians. After having preserved and enriched this heritage, they themselves transmitted it to the great thinkers of the Renaissance.



Fama Fraternitatis

At the very beginning of the 17th century, a manifesto entitled 'Fama Fraternitatis' was published by the Order in several European countries, in particular in Germany, France, and England. It is from this time that the Order was known under the name of "Order of the Rose Cross." Such famous personalities as Michael Maier, Francis Bacon, Descartes, Robert Fludd, Elias Ashmole, and Comenius were closely associated with the Rosicrucians of this period, and of course numerous female mystics who preferred to keep their names hidden from the public eye but were well respected in their esoteric circles.

Journey to the New World

In 1693, European Rosicrucians embarked for the New World aboard the ship named 'The Sarah Maria' and established themselves in Pennsylvania, where they founded several colonies. They not only introduced the authentic Rosicrucian teachings to America, but they also published many esoteric books. Under their impetus, the world of the arts, sciences, and literature experienced an unprecedented expansion in America, and many **institutions** were created as a result. Thanks to them, such eminent people as Benjamin Franklin and Thomas Jefferson were initiated into Rosicrucian philosophy from which they drew inspiration throughout their lives.

In the 19th century, the Order entered into a time of dormancy in America. However, it remained very active in France, Germany, England, Switzerland, Spain, Russia, and in the East. In the beginning of the 20th century, Dr Harvey Spencer Lewis, who had studied esotericism for many years and who was very much interested in Rosicrucianism, went to France to meet those responsible for the Order.

Ancient and Mystical Ordo Rosæ Crucis is announced

After having undergone many tests and trials, he was initiated in Toulouse and was given the responsibility of preparing for the re-emergence of the Rosicrucian Order in America, even while the First World War loomed in Europe. When all was ready for this re-emergence, a Manifesto was published to announce to the United States the new period of activity of the Order, which was then designated by the name 'Ancient and Mystical Ordo Rosæ Crucis.'

Appointed to the position of Imperator, (the highest leadership position of the Order), Dr Harvey Spencer Lewis began to commit the Rosicrucian teachings to writing, using for that purpose the archives that the Rosicrucians of France had entrusted to him. Finally, this method of teaching was made available to the whole world. In this way, AMORC became a trustee of the Rosicrucian Tradition in every country where it could freely conduct its activities.

Dr Harvey Spencer Lewis was greatly supported and inspired by May Banks-Stacey, the co-founder of AMORC. A woman of great mystical background, she had been initiated into Rosicrucianism in India and Egypt. Another woman who was a key figure in the Rosicrucian tradition was Jeanne Guesdon in France. She was a pillar of the Order, preparing and supporting all the work that made the expansion of Rosicrucianism after the Second World War possible.

After having devoted the major part of his life to serving the Order as its Imperator, Harvey Spencer Lewis passed away in 1939. His son, Ralph Maxwell Lewis, who had worked closely with him for many years, was appointed Imperator by the Supreme Council of AMORC. Working tirelessly in the service of the Rose Cross, he contributed to its spread throughout the whole world. Under his impetus, the Order

continued to develop in many countries and to spread its ideals to all continents. Known for his humanism, he also made it his duty to support ideas which contributed to the well-being of humanity and to the evolution of consciousness, leaving a work which is reflective of a great philosopher.

Then, Christian Bernard, as Imperator, modernized the structure of the Order, giving it greater stability and solidity and consolidating its worldwide dimension to become 19 different language based jurisdictions, with various headquarters located around the world. Many of these 'Grand Lodges' and their associated retreat centres are located in beautiful natural environments; in pristine forests and mountains, by lakes and rivers. Group venues similarly are found far and wide, often in the hearts of towns and cities where members can meet to hold activities together. Furthermore, a number of renown Egyptian museums and an alchemical museum opened to the public and became well established.

AMORC Today

In terms of membership numbers, the AMORC is the most successful Western mystical order of the present age with tens of thousands of participating members worldwide. Its teachings are translated into 19 languages and its groups are found in more than 450 cities.

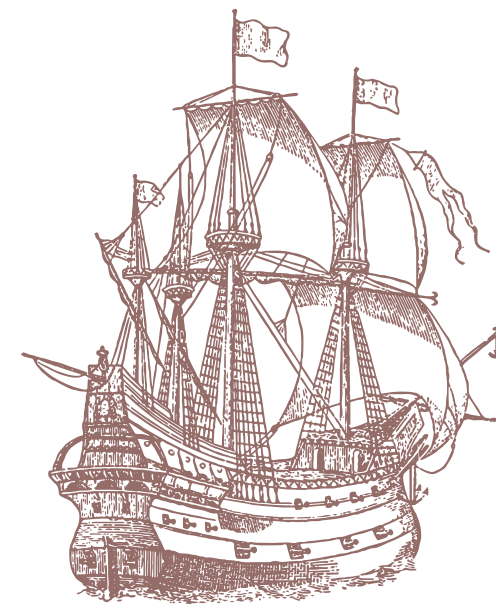
Today, it is Claudio Mazzucco who serves as Imperator, and who alongside of a worldwide 'round table' of the Supreme Board of 15 Grand Masters and administrators, leads a collaborative, ethical, inclusive and ecologically minded approach to meeting the complex needs of a 21st century organisation with the constancy of the mystical ideals of the Order.

The Australasian Jurisdiction

The English language jurisdiction of Australasia currently has its headquarters in South Australia, but it has a long lineage of activities dating back to the 1930s, with early activities in India, China, South-East Asia, Australia and New Zealand. Today, there are AMORC Rosicrucian groups who meet in person and online, across the region. The jurisdiction spans from Afghanistan to the International date line. There are currently around 20 Affiliated bodies (Rosicrucian Groups) of various sizes operating across the jurisdiction and 5 online hubs in the Australasian jurisdiction.

The Not-For-Profit charity named 'The English Grand Lodge for Australia, Asia and New Zealand' is the legal and governance body of the Australasian jurisdiction.

Alongside the teaching monographs, the Grand Lodge publishes a worldwide magazine on spirituality, 'The Rosicrucian Magazine', a members special teaching magazine, 'The Rosicrucian Forum' and a bulletin, 'Aurora Rosae' which contains both local and global news and information.



Developing Your Highest Potential



A goal of the Rosicrucian Order has been to develop a system of study for those who would like to discover the mystical path, and ancient techniques which are still useful in today's world, across all aspects of our being— physical, mental emotional, psychic and spiritual .

You will also find that some old esoteric ideas associated with Rosicrucianism, as found in ancient hermetics have been transformed into more contemporary forms of learning, supporting a pathway towards a state of 'Peace Profound' (or illumination), rather than being a mere historical or intellectual curiosity.

Although a student can study in the privacy of their own home, and even set up a special place for study, meditation and reflection, (a Home Sanctum) if they wish to, they can also meet with other students at Affiliated Bodies, or at conventions and retreats for group activities.

The Rosicrucian teachings integrate regular exercises and experiments designed to discipline your five physical senses and awaken the deeper psychic senses, often left dormant within you.

How the System of Study Works

Each month, you'll receive a packet of weekly lessons, called monographs, to read in the privacy of your own home.

The lessons, about six to eight pages each, introduce certain ideas and experiments in a straightforward and simple manner. We ask that you devote about one hour a week to study that week's lesson and carry out any exercise or experiment given. For the remainder of the week we encourage you to periodically think about the important ideas contained in that lesson and to repeat the exercises. We ask you for this simple commitment because the lessons are not just a body of knowledge, but a way of life. If you only read them and don't attempt the experiments or practice the techniques, then you're only learning theory, just as you would be if you only read a book on how to play the piano, but never practised playing one.

It's essential that you test the ideas and experiments to prove their validity to yourself. You will quickly discover that we do not insist or even ask you to believe anything in the studies. Only you can judge their validity by putting them to the test. And only you can decide whether or not to accept them into your life.



How the Information is Structured

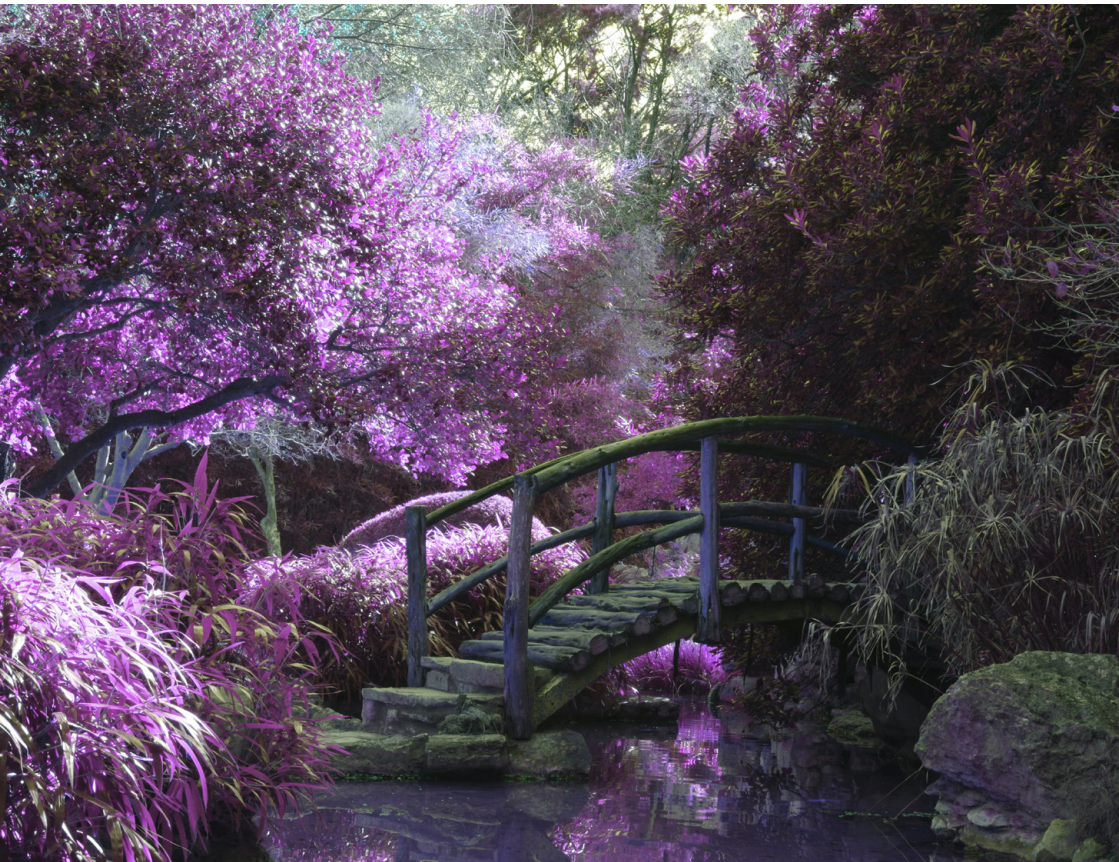
New students begin with a series of three introductory degrees comprising an overview of the Rosicrucian course of study. This is followed by twelve additional degrees, each having its own particular emphasis. The teachings are continuously updated to reflect our contemporary ideas, while keeping true to the traditions of the Order. Underlying it all is a code of natural law which forms the core of the Rosicrucian teachings and which remains constant over time.

The Rosicrucian Order, AMORC's way of learning does not promise instant enlightenment: it is a system of gentle unfoldment. In the first four or five years you will be given the necessary knowledge and techniques that will enable you to achieve a high level of proficiency in many aspects of your being. However, the teachings continue past this point bringing greater depth and advancement towards illumination.

The uniqueness of the Rosicrucian teachings doesn't come simply from the body of knowledge it offers, but also from the way in which it is organised and brought to life through practical exercises and experiments to produce a genuine evolution in consciousness. Each degree covers an important step you need in order to benefit from the following degree. Each exercise supports, reinforces, and builds upon the preceding exercises and techniques, leading to balanced, deeper development.

Initiation and Mystical Fraternity (The Initiatic Tradition)

As a member, you are not just taking a course of study. You are growing in consciousness through a graded system of degrees of study, rituals, ceremonies, exercises, and demonstrations that have a long historical background, and have been tested and tried.



Rosicrucian initiations are rituals designed to mark the milestones of a student's progress on the mystical path. In these beautiful rituals, mystical laws and principles are demonstrated in a dramatic form, to both inform and inspire you. Almost all of the Degrees of Rosicrucian study is preceded by an initiation ceremony that can easily be performed during home study. You also have the option of receiving these initiations in a more elaborate form in the Order's Affiliated groups. You'll find these initiations, when conferred in the Temple of a Rosicrucian Lodge, are breathtakingly nourishing to the psyche.

The origin of initiation is as old as the earliest civilisations. In ancient times, the word mystery referred to a unique gnosis — knowledge which was to be revealed to the candidate for initiation. In fact, in ancient Rome the mysteries were called *initia*. The initiates were called *mystae*. The Latin word *initiare* meant “to inspire”. No rite or ceremony is a true initiation if it does not do the following; (a) cause you to engage in introspection, that is, turn your consciousness within, to look upon yourself; (b) engender within you a feeling of aspiration and idealism; and (c) exact from you a sacred obligation or promise which you make to yourself that you will try to fulfil your aspirations.

The purpose of Rosicrucian initiation is for the same traditional and psychological reasons. Participation in initiation rituals does not, in itself, make you a true initiate, and Rosicrucian students are not required to participate in rituals. You become a Rosicrucian initiate only through your own efforts, merits, and preparation. However, it is possible to accelerate this inner preparation and this is the purpose of Rosicrucian initiations.

Rosicrucian Community

The Rosicrucian Order, AMORC, is a community (fraternal) organisation of women and men as well being welcoming to families, that maintains a system of local

Rosicrucian groups (Affiliated Bodies). You have the option and privilege of attending a Lodge, Chapter or Pronaos or Atrium Group if there is one in your area. 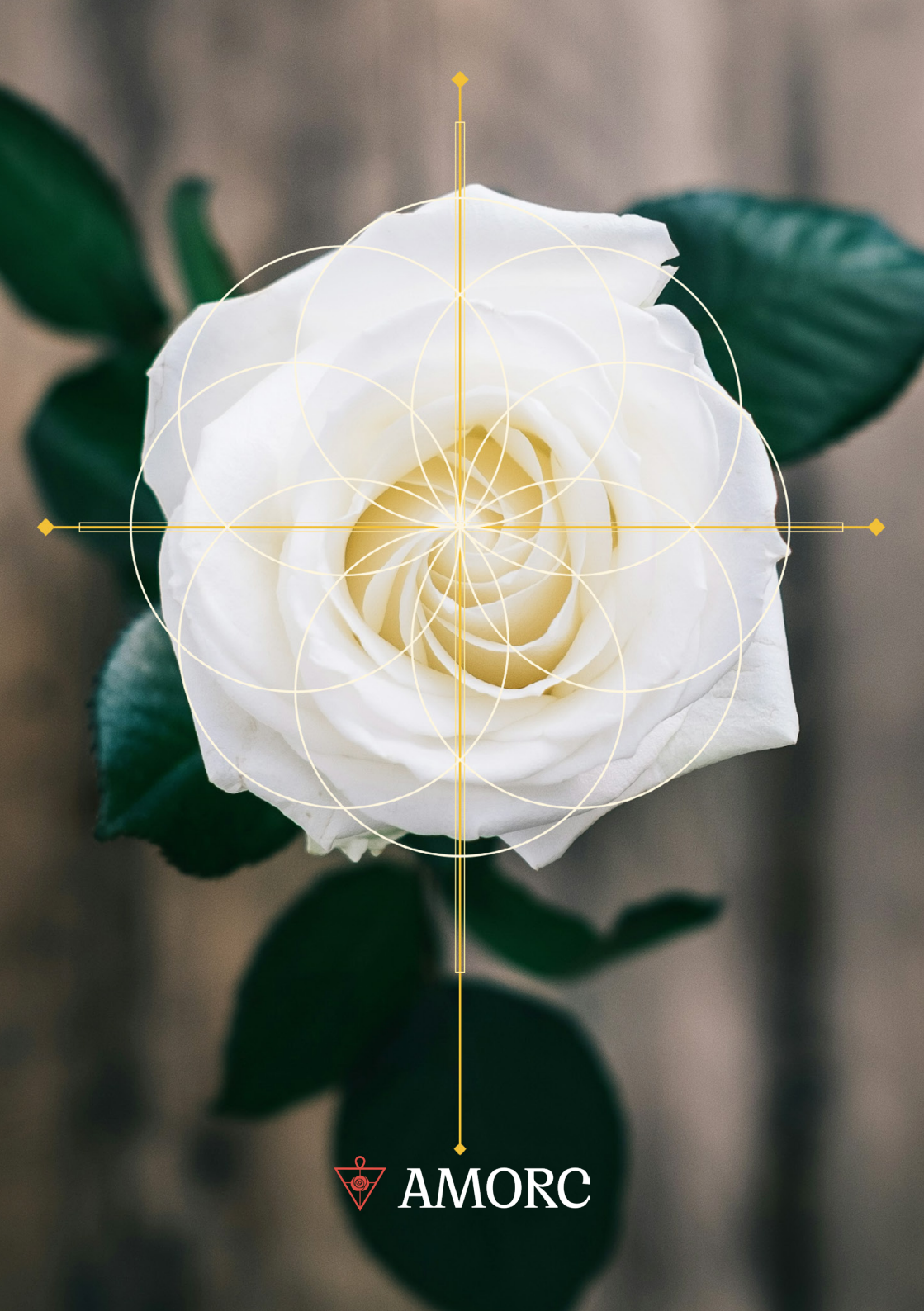
